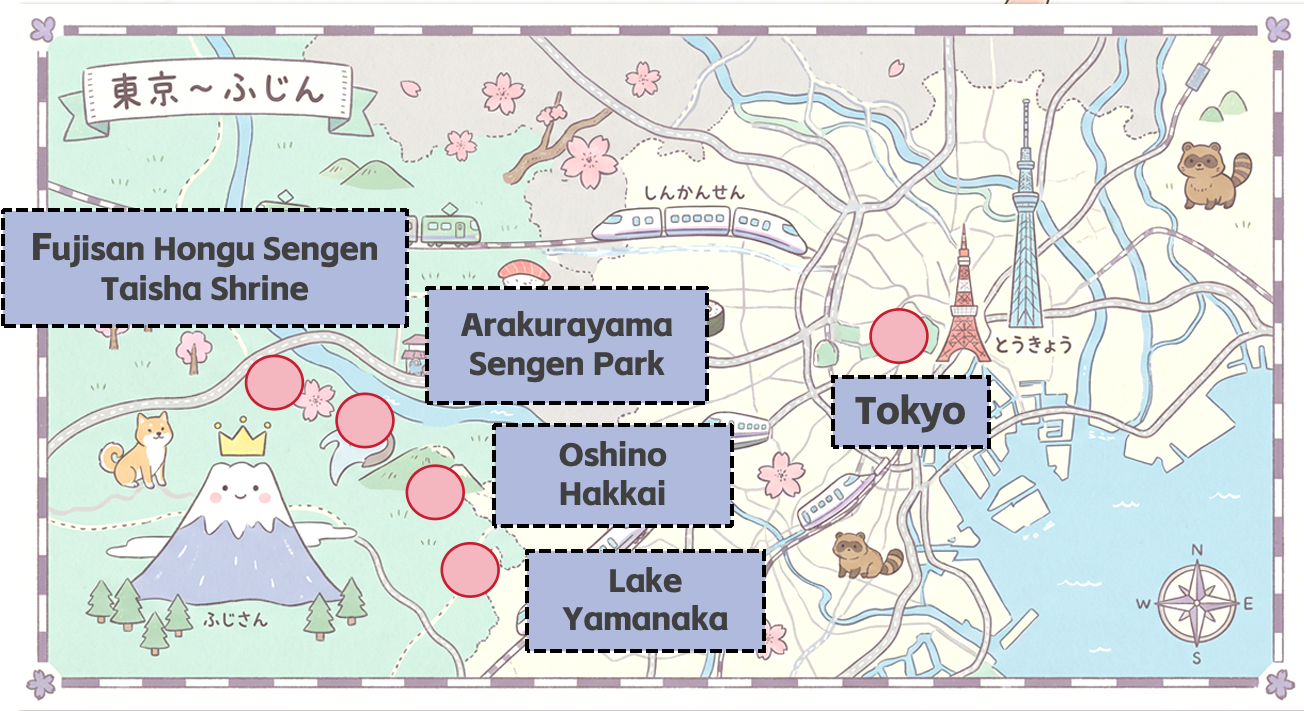

Attractions Introduction



Arakurayama Sengen Park

Famous for its classic composition of the Chureito Pagoda and Mount Fuji, it is one of the best spots to capture a postcard-perfect view



Fujisan Hongu Sengen Taisha Shrine

Fujisan Hongu Sengen Taisha is the head Sengen shrine dedicated to Mount Fuji, known for its historic grounds and the sacred Wakutama Pond



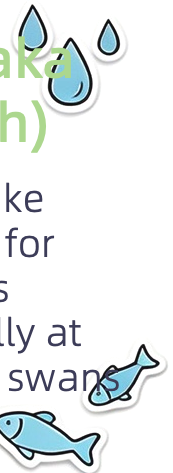
Oshino Hakkai

Formed by Mount Fuji's melted snow, these eight clear spring ponds are among Japan's "100 Famous Waters," set against traditional village scenery



Lake Yamanaka (Hirano Beach)

Hirano Beach at Lake Yamanaka is ideal for seeing Mount Fuji's reflection, especially at sunrise, often with swans in view



Food Recommendations



Sanrokuen

Traditional Japanese restaurant by Lake Kawaguchi. Enjoy robatayaki skewers, seasonal dishes, and Hötō noodles around a cozy charcoal hearth



Kosaku Kawaguchiko

Popular spot for Yamanashi's Hötō noodles. Wide noodles cooked in rich miso with seasonal vegetables; traditional tatami seating adds an authentic touch
